Dear Mirsada:

We acknowledge finally receiving the bank wire for \$93,801.70 USD in July 2023 last year that was paid back from our payment to Igman dd in December 2006; however, we are still missing the payment of \$25,221.62 USD that has been owing to us as a credit since 2005. How many years do we have wait for this money back?

In 2005 we made an overpayment of \$30,905.70 and after Mr Emir Hadzizukic outlined the deductions from the import of our vehicle load to Igman that we both agreed with (His letter of enclosed 19th October 2005. Mr. Hadzizukic's letter was very clear so what seems to be the problem?. We also asked earlier on a number of occasions about the status of the vehicle we sent Igman on indefinite loan and we are also ignored (#1). My late mother said I was too easy going which has its pluses and minuses.

On 21st December 2007 Mr. Phillip Rimer of Fraser Milner Casgrain LLP (enclosed) wrote a letter to your directors at the time demanding the return of the money only returned last July and also the \$25,221.62 USD noted above. The money was still not returned and with our own customers going behind our backs to Igman who welcomes them and cuts us out, not other orders or funds went to Igman from our company since that date.

On 19th December 2011 (enclosed) on your request we sent an invoice for the \$25,221.62 USD noted, but to date still this money had not been returned. The word of your director and the credibility of Igman as no more credibility that the signature of Dzahid Murtabegovic on Purchase order 200608CC of 14th December 2006 that Mr Murtabegovic defaulted on by not even having the ammunition produced by the end of the 130 production time he promised to honor. We sent the letter of 19th December 2011 to avoid an argument, much less a fight however, our good will was not even respected for the money that belongs to us. In the words of the late Henry Kissinger taking not only about International affairs but of people. "You can either be respected or feared, but at the end of the day either is preferable". I remind everyone concerned that are talking about our business that brought Igman dd business in 1998 onward when no one knew Igman's name and Igman was on the verge of collapse. Without Christopher

Baxter and Caina-Longbranch you would be working for the wood mill In Jablinica like Jasna Macic after she had enough, and other people at Igman would be selling fish and honey by the side of the road in Konjic. None of the business Igman now enjoys much of it built on our backs would even have been possible without us. In return we expect to be treated fairly and our decency and kindness reciprocated; however, it is not. As a plumber in northern Ontario said about his friend who won 16 million in a lottery and then “went off the rails” and later went bankrupt “with some people, a great deal of money is like adding plant “miracle gro” to all of their personal defects”. I have not changed since we first started working with Igman in 1998 for Cameron, however, your directors have like Dzahid Murtabegovic who struts around like a peacock and brags about Igman’s great success, driven by a world at war. He reminds me of Maduro of Venezuela who is actually a bus driver. I believe Mr. Murtabegovic was good as a production manager who had work with and respect other people, rather than throwing his weight around an denying me factory production visits the last several times I was at Igman. Since 1999 I paid over 60-70 trips to Igman and FBiH and the other factories including long term business development at our expense, but I note that your directors never made the effort to pay one trip to us in Canada, as your largest customer at the time before our work recognized Igman and our customers went directly to you behind our backs and your directors welcomed them (#2)

While we cannot resolve everything today, can we count on Igman d.d to finally return our \$25,221.62 USD this promptly now after 19 years of waiting, for what is quite an obscene disgrace on the credibility of Igman’s “leadership” in these unique and truly extreme circumstances? And could Igman also send us a 20ft sea container of 7.62x54 FMJ ball ammunition on consignment and we would pay Igman dd 19 years later? We sold almost 20 million rounds of that caliber when your “new found friends” were buying steel cased ammunition elsewhere to pay less and make greater profits while avoiding Igman’s higher brass cased products as we stuck with you. Better still how about just sending us a 20ft sea container of ammunition on consignment and we agree to pay Igman promptly upon sale, and then keep repeating this on an ongoing basis to cover at least some of our losses since 2006? As you said to me after one of our meetings with you directors and repeating their words to you “Caina-Longbranch has made enough money” in an appalling statement from Mr. Murtabegovic or/or Mr. Hadzizukic who paints themselves in the roll of the Bosnian victim. Well this statement is not true that we “have made enough money” as of 2006/2007. How does Igman propose to fix this problem that only we have had to endure?


(#1)What would have happened to the Minster TR-2-30 high speed M-27 & M-13 that we invested over \$500,000.00 USD in since 2009 to factory re-manufacture that we still have in stock if we had sent that to Igman. You still have all of the manuals for that as no agreement was ever concluded. Mr Hadzizkic speculated he could produce links for our General Dynamics competitors with the machine and wanted to know when it would be ready?. Why would we agree to such a suggestion that leaves us with an investment, but without any financial return? This shows a complete lack of regard and respect for us as a customer and potential investor that has worked with Igman since 1998 when the factory almost vanished like Vitez or others

(#2) On 18th August 2008 we sent you a copy of our Canadian IIC for samples to build more orders despite the problems faced, however, the permit we took the time and expense on was never acted upon by Igman, samples were never sent and that business died and went away

I also included another letter 25th July 2008 at that time asking how we were to be protected and that letter was never dealt with at Igman dd, leaving our company exposed an at the mercy of customers that would go behind our backs, primarily form the United States. The US market is now littered with adds for Igman ammunition that have completely excluded us. You get a financial return benefitting from our joint relationship since 1998 that saved the Igman factory at the time. Our company gets nothing in return, including from the Igman defaulted purchase order # 200608CC from December 2006 that was to be used as a sample to create millions of dollars worth of more U.S. Government business, if the Igman defaulted order had been delivered on time. This after producing close to 8 million U.S. dollars worth of business for the USG from 2002 onward alone. Since 1998 with Caina-Longbranch orders from Cameroon, New Zealand, Australia, Switzerland, and the United States Government, and more had we been protected as per our letter of 25th July 2008. What more can you ask for?

Subject: Default of Purchase Order No. 200608CC and Return of Funds Outstanding

Be advised that we are the solicitors for Caina-Longbranch Defence Systems (Canada) Limited ("Caina"), which has made every reasonable effort to resolve its concerns with Igman d.d. ("Igman"), but for unexplained reasons Igman refuses to even address (much less resolve) same. Specifically, we observe Caina's letter to Igman dated November 20, 2007, raising serious issues requiring Igman's immediate attention and rectification, all of which was ignored by Igman.

First, Purchase Order No. 200608CC dated December 14, 2006 constitutes a legally binding obligation between Igman and Caina governed by the laws of the Province of Ontario. For its part, Igman undertook to produce goods within 130 days of the purchase order date, which still have not been completed on time. Consequently, Caina reserves all of its rights and remedies against Igman for all resulting damages (both direct and indirect), which well exceed the initial \$93,000.00 USD payment made by Caina. Indeed, we submit that Igman's conduct of refusing to respond, as well as its improper use of packaging material provided by (and owned by) Caina, constitute an act of conversion, and we intend to seek exemplary damages in that regard.


Second, Igman has been holding \$25,221.62 USD since October 2005, which was paid in error by Caina with respect to Purchase Order No. 0560062F. Notice is hereby given that these funds are to be returned to Caina immediately and that, failing timely compliance with this request, we will again pursue all rights and remedies at law including seeking exemplary damages for "conversion" of such funds.

In light of the foregoing, Caina is prepared to resolve these issues on the following without prejudice basis. Firstly, Igman will promptly fulfill Purchase Order No. 200608CC. Upon fulfillment of this order, the balance of \$94,603.40 USD less funds of \$25,221.62 USD held in credit will be paid to Igman. Furthermore, Caina demands that a without prejudice meeting be held between the parties and their respective legal advisors in order to resolve other outstanding legal matters.

If these conditions are not promptly met, Caina has instructed us to pursue all legal remedies at our disposal without further notice. Please govern yourselves accordingly.



Dear Mr. Muratbegovic and Mrs. Kadic:

Please find enclosed copies of the two letters of authorization from 2004 and 2006 that you did not have at the meeting. This represents \$7,795,700.00 USD (almost 8 million USD) (1) given to the Igman factory only for our United States Government business from 2001/2002. Before that Igman had no U.S. Government business that we are aware of. Unfortunately our successes have now attracted others who want to take credit for our business, but before this business the U.S. Government did not even want to talk to you at all, and these other contractors were not interested at all in Igman, Pretis, Binas, BNT, Ginex or Bosnia i Herzegovina for that matter.

The question that keeps coming up again and again without an answer is how is our company's position protected? This is not a Canadian idea, a Bosnian idea, but basic, internationally accepted business practices, and international professional standards (2). This summer marks the 10th anniversary of our relationship with the Igman.

For example, and this illustrates the problem yet again. We currently have a request for 3,000 .50cal cartridge case samples and 500 projectiles for four customers, whose business is worth almost \$3,000,000.00 USD. We have another \$4 - 5,000,000.00 USD worth of U.S. Government military business. This business could be just the immediate but we must be able to work closely together as a team to make it successful. The question again comes up, - under the circumstances of the last 15 months, how is our company's work protected?

(1) not including other customers before or since, just the U.S. Government alone. This does not include the Australian, New Zealand business worth almost 2.5 million USD. I was told in 2000 by one of your colleagues that our business at this time actually saved the Igman factory who would have gone out of business without our work. Where would the Igman factory now be without this business and our ten year relationship?

(2) This sort of huge business in accordance with international commercial standards is usually protected by a distribution agreement. These sort of agreements ranges from about 10 years and a minimum of 6 years, but 8-10 years is normal. It provides protection for both parties and the opportunity for a company such as ours to re-invest for the future of both our companies just as I outlined clearly and in detail in 15th July, 2008 letter to Minister Heco on our future Namjenska Industrija Business Development plans.

1) Ammunition must be P.O.P. (Performance Oriented Packaging) marked and packaged with all U.N. markings, hazardous material markings and palletized with wood and wire protection. Please fill out and return the attached diagram to us within 5 working days.

3) . Ammunition must meet factory established protocol tests for acceptance within the established delivery time. Failure to comply could lead to cancellation of part or all of this contract.

4) After completion a random sample will be pulled and test fired to verify quality of finished product, accuracy, pressure and velocity must be within established factory specifications. All samples must pass the factory protocol testing.

5) All ammunition must meet Igman d.d. technical specifications for acceptance 12.7x99mm M-33-(MIL-C-10190 D (AR)) of these cartridges with factory ammunition test certificates.

6) Each party shall, during the term of this Agreement, and thereafter, treat as confidential any and all information learned by the other concerning the business or affairs of the other, and will:




