Dear Mr. Minchev

Further to my letter of 28th October, 2016 and our letter to our Governments regarding special assistance regarding the permits, we have heard nothing from you indicating you have anything but an empty warehouse after we have invested not only an inventory but 14 years of work only to have you selling directly to our customers at 2/3 the cost what we paid in what appears to be organized kickbacks. Attempts to get new production certificates out of Mr. Tchavdarov indicating we have actual inventory ready to inspect now have gone no where.

Please confirm if you have any inventory immediately available for inspection for us or if we have to tell our customers that all of the Bulgarian inventory is gone and both you and B&R Engineering have produced nothing for us. As noted you are now seen not as 2 companies but 1 operating together for a common purpose.

While I would like to finish this matter in an amicable way, you are giving us no choice and Mr. Tchavdarov has continuously avoided providing new production certificates which is only an indication to us that there is nothing left in your warehouse. Our customer will not accept this and they will walk away from this transaction, destroying the business we have worked hard to create. Frankly it is completely insane to have a business asset in a company that sells one of your product for years, it both good times and in bad and treat them this way. In 30 years of business we rarely see people treat other in this way, unless they have no plan for a future in the industry? It just makes no sense when we do the amount of work we have done, only to have our own customers come to you behind our backs and we get nothing in return. Nothing!. Where were our U.S. Government customers or Chemring, Multinational or your other "instant, temporary friends" to you in 2005 or 2010 when they were buying used PKM link belts in Albania for \$5.00 USD each?

Please advise if you have any inventory left or if you have truly just left us with no other alternative.

Dear Mr. Minchev

We have tried to get confirmation that the 3,000,000 PKM links owned jointly and to be sold under agreement were not replaced when your factory took them and sold them to our customers at two-thirds of our buying price.

We have tried to confirm that there is actually 3,000,000 links in stock for our customers to view right now; however, Mr. Tchavdarov is either unable or unwilling to confirm that you have nothing but an empty warehouse and our money in your pocket and not in ours.

The tragedy of this whole mess is that it is extremely rare for the Spring Factory or even B&R Engineering to have a company that has not only promoted one of your products at our expense for the past 14 years but has made millions of dollars of PKM link purchases. However it even gets better than this in that after spending the millions of dollars in purchases we turn around and bought hundreds of thousands of dollars in inventory on the condition that our so called partner Entcho Tchavdarov did the same thing and that we would sell at a fixed price that we mutually benefit. On top of that we spent our time, effort and resources over the last ten years at no cost to you when gangsters were selling 1960's Chinese belts out of Albania and other Russian belts out of Ukraine for \$5.00 USD per belt sometimes with forged new production certificates. **This is not your fault or your problem nor is it mine and claims of us not doing our job is both false and insulting without foundation.** It's one thing to have a customer that sticks with you in the good times, it's quite exceptional to have a customer that sticks with you in difficult times and sustains repeated losses in supporting a quality product when people around us are committing repeated fraud, but never once asks you to cover our expenses.

We also remind you that I made an agreement, during my visit last April 2015, with your son Dimitar in which The Spring Factory would borrow and replace the 1,000,000 links. Further more he agreed these links would only be used for your domestic orders and certainly not under any circumstances sold to our own customers thereby destroying a lot of our work. Once your son not only agreed to these arrangements that were not only confirmed by letter, but that your

son acted on by taking the 1,000,000 links he solidified the agreement. Under International Law and basic agreements it is not necessary that your company and our company have a signed joint agreement for an agreement to be legally binding but that he took the goods as offered for financial gain to you and your company and immediately violated this agreement.

Further more, whether you like it or not, by taking the 2,000,000 links which were half ours under the Caina-Longbranch/B&R Engineering agreement, we also have claim to half of those links as well. This agreement was made up and enshrined over the last 10+ years through multiple letters and documents and is also enforceable no matter what you think or say. If you disagree then you will have the pleasure as well as Mr. Tchavdarov of explaining this to the US DOJ, - Department of Justice , the enclosed invoice as just one small example (1) , who will put pressure on your government to tear your lives apart,.

You are also forgetting the incident in 2004 which was actually brought to us by extremely angry members of the American government who told us that I along with the American distributor and American government inspector should not enter Bulgaria in the Fall of 2004 because we were to be arrested on God knows what fraudulent false charges to get us to drop the order so that Arsenal could take our production. As the American Government explained to us, Arsenal was angry after we ran the order for the 8,500,000 PKM links because they were afraid of losing one of their own contracts for lack of links. This was after Mr. Botev walked into your factory and took the tooling out of the newly purchased machine until you honored your agreement to deliver the 8,500,000 PKM links that Arsenal was trying to "hi-jack" figuratively speaking. Before you and the Spring Factory were seen as possible victims in this mess; however now, with your current offences this year and last year, which are no different than 2004, you will now be seen as complicit or liable. You no longer have the defence of the Spring Factory being forced by Arsenal to do this which was a weak defence anyway. Even if you didn't profit from the 2004 offences it will be clear enough that you were involved. The fact that you were also allowing Mr. Tchavdarov to sell PKM links out the "front door" to us for 14 years for \$15.00 USD per belt, while you sell them out the "back door" for \$10.00 USD per belt subjects the Spring Factory to an international anti-dumping case, a violation of the ISGCA - International Sales of Goods Contracts Convention Act. Because Mr. Tchavdarov expresses no other opinion now than the ones you tell him to express as he is not even his own person now that Mr. Botev is no longer involved there could also be an investigation into "kick-backs" between your company and B&R Engineering. Even if the kick-backs was not the case, the 2004 offences implicate you and your factory in the American Foreign Corrupt Practices Act and because the Americans were informed of this initially through their own Intelligence Services. If this matter blows up the Americans will involve their Department of Justice and in turn ask the Bulgarian authorities to tear apart the lives of Alexandar Minchev and Entcho Tchavdarov to get to the bottom of this mess which "stinks" already. It only looks bad because it is bad and nothing can change that.

Right now we are entitled to have 3,000,000 brand new PKM links in-stock at your factory ready for immediate October 2016 delivery without waiting, problems, questions or comment (it is not about permits, it is about immediate stock and orders already placed and paid for that should have been replaced last year). This is what our customers are depending on based on our ten years of advertising, our offers (almost 1,000 offers in the last ten years at our expense), and our website shows 3,000,000 PKM links in stock in Europe. With the current warfare going on now some of this is a pending American customer not interested in the price games and our already fair prices, and also to three American allies. If you cannot provide an immediate inventory available right now, with current production certificates and lots, the customers will walk away. This will mean that you violated one agreement with us and participated in violating another agreement, while you have taken our own money and effectively used it against us with some of our own customers (this act alone reminds us more of gangsters than genuine business). In this case we will be forced to defend ourselves by outlining the whole ugly story to our customers going back to the offences of 2004. If you provoke these people including the Americans and discredit us (because we trusted you), these people will unleash The Department of Justice just as an opening introduction and their Bulgarian colleagues will have a field day with you and Mr. Tchavdarov.

When I went to visit the American government customers in May 2016 in Tampa, Florida they were more than usually friendly toward me because they were upset about buying property from Chemring and Multinational because it was not only clear that this was our property but the customer was tricked into buying at the lowest price because at the time they were not aware of what it took to create such a low price, and that we were not even paid for our own property. Even if another order was placed they know that this sort of mess and scandal is not unlike the AEY Scandal that embarrassed and discredited members of the US Government. Also, if the US Government is caught up with suppliers involved in the Foreign Corrupt Practices Act, and anti-dumping case, goods belonging to us that we were never paid for and the violation of the ISGC Act, plus your own broken agreement which will make some of the US Government look negligent which is a political career ender. Even if only half of the legal consequences were enforced the US Government cannot afford to have such a risky reputational scandal over PKM links. This places you and The Spring Factory in an extremely bad situation starting with the 2004 offences which are exceptionally serious and won't go away because it makes you look like you are doing the exact same thing again.

If you both adhered to this agreement last April 2015 your factory would have received your \$10.00 USD per 100 rd with starter tab Mr. Tchavdarov would have received his \$15.00 USD per belt and we would have received our \$20.63 USD per belt and everybody would have been happy since as you know we have already sold over 10,000,000 links before the 4,000,000 without any problems or issues of any sort. This view is not just my opinion but it is the view and opinion of anyone who works to build and maintain long-term productive business relationships with others. Does this sound like people who intend to stay in business? Really?

Right now it is not just that the 3,000,000 PKM links have been sold to one of our customers using our own money but they were sold at 2/3's of our buying price since 2002 which is frankly obscene! Other customers will continue to buy the PKM links combine it with ammunition and sell them for much more than we have ever charged just as Arsenal did when they sold the belts for \$29.00 each since the 1990's. We refuse to charge any more because we already had a fair profit margin; however, we are now suffering substantial losses due to your actions. We will absorb the losses and expenses in the difficult years but expect to make a profit in the good years. Please keep in mind unlike Arsenal we will hold inventory and advertise without any cost to you.

The only way out of your current predicament is to pay us what is owing for the 3,000,000 PKM links sold, and whether you pay us for these links or Mr. Tchavdarov it is not our concern. Under the agreement if you have nothing left in stock we are legally entitled and these are enforceable entitling us to the following: (we are using rounded numbers for simplicities sake).

Bulgarian Stock: (3,000,000 links in-stock)

- 1.) For the 1,500,000 links we are entitled to \$20.63 USD per 100 round belt totaling \$309,450.00 USD (this is \$20.63 USD x 15,000 belts)
- 2.) For B&R's portion of the 3,000,000 links (1,500,000 links) we are entitled to \$5.63 USD per 100 round belt totaling \$84,450.00 USD (this is \$5.63 USD x 15,000 belts or our portion/profit on B&R's ½ of the 3,000,000 links.

This means that you and B&R Engineering operating as a single entity and not as two companies owe our company \$393,900.00 USD. (\$309,450.00 USD + \$84,450.00 USD)

American Stock: (1,000,000 links in-stock)

- 1.) For the 500,000 links we are entitled to \$20.63 USD per 100 round belt totaling \$103,150.00 USD (this is \$20.63 USD x 5,000 belts)
- 2.) For B&R's 500,000 links we are entitled to \$5.63 USD per 100 round belt totaling \$28,150.00 USD (this is \$5.63 USD x 15,000 belts or our portion/profit on B&R's ½ of the 3,000,000 links.

This means that we owe you/B&R Engineering operating as a single entity \$131,300.00 USD from the American inventory. (\$103,150.00 USD + \$28,150.00 USD)

The settling of the accounts in this 4,000,000 PKM link agreement is as follows but does not take into account that you have sold to our customers behind our back and caused significant damage and loss.

- A.) From Bulgaria you owe us \$393,900.00 USD
- B.) From USA we owe both of your companies working as a single entity \$131,300.00 USD

This leaves a balance that both your companies owe us a balance of \$262,600.00 USD. In order to pay us for the links that have been sold behind our backs.

This money is long past due and is to be paid immediately by bank wire to avoid civil prosecution. This is to be paid directly into our Bank account in US dollars. This is also the only legitimate way to save face and tell the customers that the 3,000,000 PKM links in Bulgaria have been sold and that we have been paid and that the first delivery of the next 1,000,000 links beyond the 3,000,000 would be available in 60 days; and subsequent deliveries would be 150 days for additional 2,000,000 links.

Bulgarian Export Permit Assistance for Combat Operations

Your Excellencies

We are writing you for special assistance, to expedite Bulgarian Export Permits for 7.62 x 54R PKM metal machine gun links from Bulgaria to the United States based on an application that B&R Engineering Ltd. of Sofia would have submitted by 15th October 2016 going to the United States

In the past we have also organized exports for the U.S. government to be either flown into Ramstein Air Force base in Germany or about 300 - 20ft sea containers by rail into the U.S. Army Ammunition Depot in Germany. Either may be an option with current combat operations.

There are currently 3,000,000 PKM links that we have in stock in Bulgaria that will either go to Germany for the U.S. Government's current combat aid operations or go to the United States on the export permit submitted before 15th October 2016 for further shipment out of U.S. Air Bases in the Unites States.

This matter will go ahead based on the inspection of the 3,000,000 PKM links now in Bulgaria and the 900,000 + PKM links now in the United States (air lift packing list enclosed of the American based inventory for one of the American allied recipients)







As a true non-profit, the 1stNAEF is not motivated by short-term monetary gain, but rather by long-term solutions that make real impact on improving human lives. Whatever the problem of the conflict region, we are in it personally and for the long-haul. Our approach addresses real-world issues and needs based on the assessment of those in need themselves, not abstract models. As a result, those assisted have a sense of ownership in the solutions and recognize the value of cooperation, and foster inclusiveness over conflict and competition, towards providing a better life for everyone. Our workers on the ground in conflict zones are dedicated, but what they require is the financial and material support of those who are equally dedicated but cannot join them in-country to help those in need. Medical supplies and medical aid development have been identified by our teams as extremely high within Kurdistan, to address this need we have created a project titled “Crate for Care” to deliver lifesaving relief supplies.

What we need for our Crate for Care Project?

We need to raise \$15,000 to send a shipment of medical supplies and equipment to Kurdistan. The faster we meet our goal, the more quickly we can have the container on its way! *Fundraising will continue until our goal is achieved.

Collected supplies are being donated to The 1st by Care Convoy, with an estimated value of over \$250,000 USD worth of medical relief supplies.

What does \$15,000 cover?

- Supply Collection and Storage costs to date.
- Packing and Loading for Shipment.
- Movement for Distribution in Kurdistan.

Where will these supplies go and how will they be used?

These supplies will be shipped from their current location in Idaho to Northern Iraq, and will be used for two purposes.

- 1) A small portion of the supplies will be selected for use in 1st NAEF medical development programs in Kurdistan (bandages).
- 2) The larger portion is marked for delivery to the refugee camp medical station, of 1st NAEF rescue effort Hanin Salo, located in the Dohuk Province of Iraqi Kurdistan.
